

CODE OF CONDUCT - LIQUOR

- Drunken members or their guests will not be served liquor. A person is drunk if the person's speech, balance, co-ordination or behaviour appears to be noticeably impaired; and it is reasonable in the circumstances to believe that that impairment results from the consumption of liquor.
- Persons under the age of 18 years will not be served liquor. Bar personnel may require proof of age – photo ID such as Driver's Licence or Passport
- Complaints from customers or residents may be in writing and sent to the President, Lesmurdie Tennis Club, PO Box 91, Kalamunda, 6926. The Management Committee of the Club will investigate the complaint and take appropriate action with a view to resolving it
- Harm minimisation strategies include:
 - Availability of a meal on Friday evening sessions
 - Availability of bar snacks or meal on Saturday or Sunday afternoon/evening sessions
 - Availability of non-alcoholic drinks and mid strength beer
 - Unavailability of hard liquor (ie spirits)
 - Provision of drinking water free of charge
 - Provision of volunteer staff trained in responsible serving of liquor
- Patrons on leaving the premises are reminded to respect the rights of neighbours and not to disturb the amenity of the local area
- Volunteer staff will engage in responsible server practices with a view to minimising the potential harm or ill-health to patrons due to the consumption of liquor

The Lesmurdie Tennis Club holds a Restricted Club Licence granted under the terms of the Liquor Control Act 1998 (LCA).

This licence allows the sale of liquor to Club members and their guests on certain days, at certain times and under certain conditions.

The Management Committee of the Lesmurdie Tennis Club, the Approved Managers (under the terms of the LCA), and its bar staff are committed to minimising the potential harm or ill-health to members and their guests, due to the use of liquor.
